MINUTES OF THE FIFTH ANNUAL MEETING

FIRST SESSION

The fifth annual meeting of the South Dakota Academy of Science was held in the Science Lecture Room of Dakota Wesleyan University at Mitchell, S. D., Tuesday, November 26, 1919.

President Freeman Ward took the chair at 10:00 o'clock. On account of the few members present the morning session was devoted to the business of the Academy, while the papers were left for the afternoon session.

On motion, Article 4, Section 1, of the constitution was amended to read "a Secretary-Treasurer," instead of "a Secretary and a Treasurer."
